

#### HOW IS YOUR HEART?

Do you remember how the nation of Israel got its first king. The people wanted Saul to be their king because he was tall and good looking. But the measure that God uses differs from one humans tend to use.

We find that recorded in 1 Samuel 16:1: But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him. For the Lord sees not as a man sees; man looks on the outward appearance, but the Lord looks on the heart."

You see, Saul was quite impressive in his outward appearance, but what people couldn't see was his heart, a heart that would rot in arrogance, unfaithfulness, and insecurity. Centuries have passed since Saul and David walked on earth, and yet people haven't changed much in the standards by which they judge others. But the true measure of a man or woman can be taken only in the heart. So what does God see when looking into our hearts? Sin! We have sin on the outside and sin on the inside too!

Years after God chose David to be king, David discovered the sin problem himself. He prayed, "Create in me a clean heart, O God." (Psalm 51:10) The word create evokes an image from Genesis chapter 1, where we are told that God created everything from nothing but his word. David was asking God for a heart transplant, a completely new and clean heart.

God's word of forgiveness created that heart in David. And God's Word of grace in Jesus Christ, in his cross and open tomb, created new hearts in us too. When God looks into your heart, he sees Christ's gift of faith—and all the good things that go along with it. Praise the Lord for creating, and continuing to renew a clean heart within you. Join us in worship each Sunday morning as we all thank God for our faith and trust in Jesus Christ!


It's On! It's been a while since our last church rummage sale. Do you have lots of items waiting for a new home?!!
