GLORIOUS FREEDOM

This time of the year it is not unusual to hear pastors/preachers talk about our freedom in Christ. People are assumedly thinking about freedom around the 4th of July and many of us pastors feel like it is important to touch upon the freedom that God has provided us through the gift of his Son, Jesus the Christ. The verse from Galatians chapter 5 is often presented in the discussion. In fact let me share it with you here:

It is for freedom that <u>Christ has set us free</u>. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery. — <u>Galatians 5:1</u>

Pastors also like to turn to Romans 8, where Paul uses the phrase "the freedom and glory of the children of God" to refer to both the present reality of God's children and a future in which hope becomes realized and suffering is only a distant memory. This glorious freedom is based on our relationship to our Father God as his children.

The opportunity of being God's child, as opposed to being a servant or slave, is an invitation to a life of freedom. God's forgiven children are free from the condemnation of sin (<u>Romans 8:1-</u><u>2</u>). The power of canceled sin means that hell no longer has a claim on our soul. We are free from sin and its eternal condemnation.

We are free from slavery to sin as well, free to serve God joyfully. This freedom occurs when our hearts have been so changed by God that we follow the Holy Spirit and actually desire to do what pleases the Father. Genuine freedom involves doing what we were designed to do, being who we were created to be.

The wonderful combination of freedom and glory is the norm for believers who have experienced the radical forgiveness of grace through Christ and are eager to serve together with fellow sons and daughters of God in the Father's kingdom.

Come to church this week and celebrate this great truth with us. It's your opportunity to thank God for the freedom that is ours through his Son, Jesus Christ. I hope to see you in church!
